What are the strengths of the provision

- The Early Educator and her Assistant offer warm, supportive interactions with all children, ensuring they are happy and encouraged to share and play with their peers.
- Expressive and exciting story reading, dancing and singing activities are actively encouraged at the setting, promoting an environment where children can freely express themselves.
- The Early Educator carefully considers children's interests when designing exciting activities.
- British Values are well supported at the setting with children motivated to make their own choices and follow clear rules and boundaries.
- Parental relationships are excellent with parents stating that the Early Educator, 'goes above and beyond every day and cares so much' and she has offered the 'most amazing start to our childcare journey'.
- The Early Educator offers a varied and nutritious menu each day with choices including homemade vegetable curry with chickpeas and Italian beef stew.
- Children enjoy a wide variety of daily outdoor learning experiences; including visits to the local nature reserve and weekly singing sessions with the wider community.
- Children benefit from weekly cooking sessions, with family members actively encouraged to share this experience at home.

Comments on Safeguarding

- Safeguarding is effective. Children's well being is a priority for the Early Educator and her Assistant. Both practitioners fully understand their role and responsibilities in safeguarding children and they can confidently explain their local reporting procedures.
- The Early Educator and Assistant have a strong understanding of wider safeguarding concerns and can confidently list possible signs and symptoms they will consider when safeguarding children.

What does the childminder need to do to improve?

- Ensure bespoke professional development is accessed to meet the individual needs of children.
- Strengthen the use of assessments to ensure children make even better progress.
