#### **What are the strengths of the provision**

- The Early Educator is a deeply passionate practitioner who strives to offer outstanding support to each child in her care. Through extremely positive relationships, both the Early Educator and her Assistant ensure every day is packed full of adventure with a plethora of exciting opportunities offered.
- A highly ambitious curriculum is woven into the stimulating challenges her children are presented with. Rigorous assessments completed by the Early Educator and her assistant ensure that each carefully planned activity meets the individual needs of the children allowing them to make rapid progress.
- Deeply supportive attachments are offered to younger children as they clap, smile and giggle when they interact with the Early Educator; whilst older children are appropriately challenged through brilliant questioning.
- Excellent interactions are offered as the Early Educator dedicates time throughout each day to spend with small groups of children to strengthen their attachments and bonds.
- Children are immersed into a Home Nursery that promotes and celebrates local festivals and cultures, respecting each child's background and heritage.
- The Early Educator offers many opportunities for children to become engaged in the community with learning at local museums, trips to shops to buy ingredients for meals and nature walks in wildlife areas and parks.
- Parent's highly value the care and support the Early Educator offers their children, they describe her as 'extremely warm and helpful' and state that they would 'highly recommend' her services.
- Children's behaviour is fantastic. They freely share toys, demonstrate excellent manners and follow simple rules. They are extremely kind to their peers and encourage each other to join in with games.

#### **Comments on Safeguarding**

- Safeguarding is effective. Children's wellbeing and welfare is highly valued and they clearly feel safe and secure in the Early Educator and her Assistant's Home Nursery.
- The Early Educator and Assistant demonstrate a robust and vigilant approach to keeping children safe. They have a strong understanding of the local reporting procedures and identifying symptoms for a variety of safeguarding concerns.
