#### What are the strengths of the provision

- The Early Educator has an exceptional understanding of each child in her care. Extremely positive and respectful relationships are evident, meaning children feel safe and valued in their learning environment.
- Thorough assessments ensure children make rapid progress towards their individual targets. The Early Educator completes regular observations to track progress and highlight any areas that children may benefit from additional support.
- The Early Educator and her assistant immerse children in a language rich environment to develop communication skills at every opportunity. Children are actively encouraged to repeat key phrases and words in play.
- Children's behaviour is outstanding. They frequently use manners as they communicate and share toys well. They understand the clear boundaries put in place to keep them safe.
- Communication and relationships with parents are incredible. Informative newsletters and regular updates are provided to ensure they are fully engaged in their child's learning journey. Parents value the 'varied, fun, age-appropriate but stimulating activities' offered each day.
- Daily outdoor learning opportunities are carefully considered and closely linked to children's interests and current topics such as trips to soft play centres and nature walks.
- A comprehensive evaluation process ensures the Early Educator and her assistant effectively reflect on the activities they offer children. They constantly consider how to further support children in their learning and offer opportunities that appropriately challenge them .
- The Early Educator and her assistant offer a broad range of foods on their weekly menu, inspired by dishes from around the world, that celebrate other cultures such as Jamaican brown stewed chicken and chow mein noodles.

#### Comments on Safeguarding

- Safeguarding is effective. The Early Educator and her assistant demonstrate a robust understanding of their local reporting procedures and remain vigilant to possible risks to children's welfare.
- The Early Educator and her assistant have a thorough understanding of a range of wider safeguarding concerns including witchcraft, county lines and the Prevent Duty.
